

What to expect

St Peter's is set apart from the village and contains a mixture of craftsmanship from several periods. The earliest parts were built by the Normans. Two family war graves in the churchyard for Harold Victor Collins and Frank Currington. Situated in the Great Ouse Valley between St Neots and Huntingdon.

Red Route 8km/5 miles

Orange Route 5.5km/3.5 miles

Duration

Red Route 2 hours 15 minutes

Orange Route 1 hour 15 minutes

Difficulty

Moderate— some narrow / uneven sections and can be muddy after rain
