



South Devon Cycle Trail

This dramatic and rewarding 30 mile cycle route takes you through some of South Devon's most beautiful countryside to discover four rural churches cared for by The Churches Conservation Trust.

West Ogwell

The Church, West Ogwell, Newton Abbot, Devon, TQ12 6EW

A winding lane twists through the countryside until you arrive at this medieval church with stunning views.

The simple church stands on a knoll beside the former manor house. The chancel and nave date from about 1300, with the tower added in about 1400. The elegant interior - with its box pews, tiered benches and elegantly curved communion rails - is mostly Georgian.

Holy Trinity Church, Torbryan Hill, Newton Abbot, Devon, TQ12 5UR

Torbryan



Narrow Devonshire lanes wind through an atmospheric and wooded valley until you discover Holy Trinity - a building of surprising size and grandeur in the hamlet of Torbryan.

The church is a perfect example of the Gothic Perpendicular style and was unusually constructed in one 20-year building campaign between 1450 and 1470. The superb, soaring tower rises in three stages, and has a dramatic octagonal stair turret.



Inside there is a beautifully carved medieval rood screen that spans the width of the church, dividing the interior with its graceful arches. Visitors can discover the story of the screen - including its survival of the Reformation and, more recently, the theft and subsequent return of 2 of the panels - with new interactive displays in the church.

The delicacy of the wood carving is echoed by the elegant tracery of the windows, many of which contain Medieval stained glass.

North Huish

St Mary's Church, North Huish, South Brent, Devon, TQ10 9NQ

This beautiful stone-spired church is a landmark in a fold in the hills just below Dartmoor with wonderful views to the south.

St Mary's was built in the fifteenth century and the tower and stone spire remain largely unaltered. Inside, the furnishings are mostly Victorian, as are the memorials that line the church walls including one to the widow 'Admonition Strode'.

St Peter the Poor Fisherman, Stoke Beach, Plymouth, Devon, PL8 1HE Revelstoke

The rugged remains of this medieval church sit dramatically on a cliff above Stoke Bay, looking out over the sea.

The Church of St Peter the Poor Fisherman has a strangely monastic feel. The aisle and porch have carved wagon roofs, but the rest of this atmospheric church is a picturesque ruin. In 1870 the parishioners abandoned it, in favour of the new church built at Noss.

Old Church House Inn

Torbryan, Devon, TQ125UR

The Old Church House Inn dates from the 13th Century.

The inn has a number of unique features, including one of England's oldest bread ovens, panelling retrieved from a ship of the Spanish Armada and 3 large log fires for cosy winter evenings.

There is an excellent restaurant serving local, seasonal food at lunchtime and in the evening. There is a lawned garden area for al fresco dining and drinking.





